As one of the community services offered by *Chisholm Services for Children*, LINKS is a comprehensive literacy skills program for students in grades primary to six.

LINKS is designed for children who need support with literacy development or diagnosed with a learning difference and could benefit from improvement in their phonologic awareness, reading fluency, comprehension, and writing skills.

The LINKS Program is dedicated to helping children become competent and independent learners by building their confidence and trying to create positive experiences with good books and writing.

How Does LINKS Work?

An initial assessment will be conducted by the LINKS Program Manager to determine a student's LINKS levels. This assessment consists of various activities, observations and parental input.

Students will work in small groups with trained Literacy Instructors who provide adapted programming based on each student's learning needs –targeting reading, writing and phonological processing skills.

The LINKS Program is based on the latest research and best practices around emergent readers and strives to build on assets present in our community. We regularly research and analyze LINKS curriculum to make sure we are providing the best program possible.
